SUBJECT: Volunteers Needed!!

Thank you for your organization’s past participation in the Little River Blue Crab Festival. Celebrating its 31st year, this year’s festival, scheduled for May 19-20, promises to be the biggest and best ever! Approximately 40,000 folks attended last year’s festival, with the festival being named “Best of the Beach” by the Sun News newspaper. More visitors than ever are expected this coming year.

The Blue Crab Festival has always been blessed with a great group of volunteers. However, as the festival has grown and our volunteers have become older or moved from the area, we have had to reach out to recruit additional volunteers to assist in selling gate tickets, Coca Cola and water products, and at the souvenir tent.

In 2012, the Blue Crab Festival will be accepting up to fifteen (12) community service organizations, church groups and other civic and non-profit groups to have a booth at the festival. Again this year, the festival will charge a \$100.00 booth fee for the two-day festival. However, **the booth fee will be waived if your club or organization can assist the Blue Crab Festival with a little volunteer help** in the areas mentioned above.

To waive the booth fee, your organization or club will need to donate a minimum of thirty-six (36) volunteer hours to the festival. Generally, volunteers work in four hour shifts during the morning, mid-day, or afternoon on either of the two festival days. That means that nine (9) volunteers would need to work a four hour shift on either Saturday or Sunday. Of course, we have so much fun at the festival, volunteers can certainly work more hours if they wish.

It will be necessary for the new volunteers to attend an organization meeting, usually held the week before the festival to sign up for their volunteer shifts and to receive their pay for the festival – a limited edition volunteer Blue Crab Festival t-shirt that will not be available for sale to the public.

Enclosed is your vendor application. Please complete the application and note whether your organization prefers to pay the \$100.00 vendor fee or supply the volunteers necessary so that the fee will be waived.
